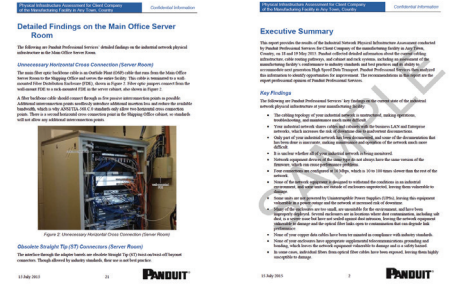

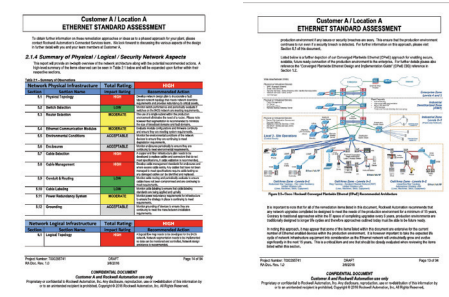

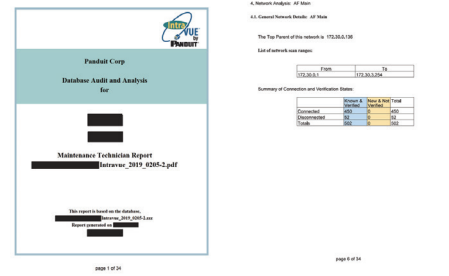
- Physical review of the network infrastructure. Includes:
 - Infrastructure evaluation including telecom spaces, IT network switching, industrial distribution frames, edge network distribution across the entire enterprise from the data center to the machine.
 - All results are compiled into a complete report that includes the spaces evaluated, key findings and recommendations, summarized score card, and RCDD review.



- Logical assessment of how the network is operating. Includes:
 - Inventory of major network components including network switches, routers and firewalls
 - Baseline comparison of physical, logical, and security-based elements against industry standards
 - Recommended remediations to current network infrastructure challenges and actionable next steps



- Connected device review and mapping. Includes:
 - Objective rating of 7+ functional areas, based on industry standards and best practices
 - Switch network topology and mapping
 - Identification of network connected devices
